State, county and local historical, genealogical, preservation, patriotic and/or museum organizations are encouraged to nominate their most significant member for a History Hero Award by completing this form and submitting it with supporting documentation. Criteria for the award include dedicated supporting service for the organization's programs, or a recent significant contribution to state and local history through research, interpretation, publication or preservation. Nominations may only be submitted by a historical, genealogical, preservation, museum, patriotic or like organization through its official representative or officer. Nominations <u>must be signed in blue ink</u> by the group's officer or designated representative, and must be postmarked no later than 31 December 2022. History Hero Awards will be presented during the annual History Day program at The Culture Center on Thursday, 23 February 2023. Nominations will be reviewed in accordance with the enclosed rules. Notification will be mailed to groups making nominations and to all successful nominees on 27 January 2023. While it is not mandatory, successful nominees are requested to be present to receive their History Hero Award during the program on 23 February 2023. A complete list of all rules is attached.

WEST VIRGINIA HISTORY HERO CRITERIA

- 1. The purpose of this award is to give state-level recognition to ONE individual (*husband and wife will be considered as one nomination only if they worked as a team on a project*) per organization (historical, genealogical, preservation, patriotic, and/or museum) per year for his/her dedicated service for the organization's programs or a recent significant contribution to state and local history through research, interpretation, preservation, publication, or web site presentation.
- 2. The West Virginia History Hero Award is a one-time only recognition. A listing of previous recipients may be found at http://archive.wvculture.org/history/historyday/historyheroalpha.html.
- 3. State, county and local historical, genealogical, preservation, patriotic and/or museum organizations are encouraged to complete the nomination form and provide supporting documentation to nominate a member who has made a significant contribution within the past year, or for years of dedicated, continued service for a West Virginia History Hero Award. Nominations may only be submitted by official action of an organization and not by individuals and MUST be signed by an officer or designated representative who is NOT the nominee.
- 4. West Virginia History Hero Award recognition will only be given to a person who is living or who died no more than 12 months prior to the December 31 deadline for submission of a nomination.
- 5. Those persons holding a public office or employeed by a state, county, or local government agency may not be nominated for activities or service they performed as a part of their duties.
- 6. A 100-word description, which lists and describes the candidate's achievements, MUST be provided. A nomination which exceeds this may not be considered by sponsors. The program's biographical sketch will be abstracted from this. Supporting documentation is necessary to assist sponsors in determining eligibility.
- 7. Supporting documentation, as requested in number 6 above, will not be returned but will be retained by Archives and History.
- 8. Submitters will be notified at least one week prior to West Virginia History Day of the success or failure of their nomination. The submitter will inform its nominee of the acceptance and arrange transportation to Charleston for him/her. It is preferred that nominees be present to receive their award; however, if that is not possible, arrangements should be made for a pro tem.
- 9. The only reason for cancellation of West Virginia History Day is closing of State Government for a reason as ordered by the Governor.
- 10. Deadline for submission of West Virginia History Hero nominations is set annually for December 31 for each succeeding year. Nominations should be mailed to:
