AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN FOLLOWING EACH CONTEST • WEST VIRGINIA RESIDENTS ONLY

RULES

- 1. Each contestant must play two (2) tunes appropriate for the category entered.
- 2. Each contestant may have a maximum of two (2) accompanists.
- 3. Each contestant should remember that popular crowdpleasing tunes may not be in their best interest.
- 4. Medley-style tunes are not acceptable.
- 5. No electric instruments are allowed.
- 6. Scruggs tuners may not be used in the banjo competition.
- 7. In case of a broken string, the contestant may replay.
- 8. In case of major tuning changes, the contestant may replay.
- 9. In case of a tie there will be a playoff.
- 10. All contestants must be West Virginia residents.
- 11. All winners are required to submit their Social Security number in order to collect their prize.
- 12. Youth winners must have their own Social Security number to collect their prize. Parents' Social Security numbers will not be accepted.
- 13. Awards ceremonies for most contests will take place following contest.
- 14. First Place winners in the old-time fiddle, old-time banjo, bluegrass banjo, mandolin, lap dulcimer and flat pick guitar contests this year will not be eligible to compete in that category next year.

- This does not apply to the Senior (60 and over) category. It also does not apply to the youth category, unless that person placed first in the 59 and under category as well as in the 15 and under category.
- 15. Winners will receive an award check in the mail within three weeks.
- 16. In order to process your award quickly, winners will need to fill out a standard W-9 form, an invoice form and supply us with **your Social Security number**. Winners in the youth category must have their own social security number and be accompanied by a parent when filling out the form.

JUDGING CATEGORIES

- 1. **Intonation** Tuning and tonal qualities
- 2. **Timing** Accurate and consistent rhythm
- 3. **Difficulty** Complexity of selections
- 4. **Technique** Dexterity in performance
- 5. **Selection** Choice of tunes appropriate to category

JUDGES

A committee of acknowledged out-of-state resident experts will judge all categories. Decisions of the judges will be final. Final scores will not be given to contestants.
